10.45 – 12.00	Guided tour of Kronborg Castle Kronborg Castle is one of northern Europe's most important Renaissance castles. Known all over the world from Shakespeare's <i>Hamlet</i> , it is also the most famous castle in Denmark
12.15	Departure from Kronborg Castle
12.45 – 14.30	Lunch at the Sletten Inn, Sletten
15.00 – 16.00	Guided tour of the Karen Blixen Museum, Rungstedlund, Rungsted The Museum occupies the house in which Karen Blixen was born, and to which she returned in 1931 following 17 years as a farmer in Africa. She lived at Rungstedlund until her death in 1962 and it was here that she wrote all her internationally renowned stories. Behind the house itself there are 40 acres of land - garden, meadow and grove. The area is preserved as a bird sanctuary, but is open to visitors. Karen Blixen was buried in the grounds, at the foot of Ewald's Hill.
