# PREAMBLE First Paragraph

# European Parliament

#### Amendment:

These Rules of Procedure practical arrangements are designed to facilitate and improve the work of the Interparliamentary Conference on Stability, Economic Coordination and Governance in the European Union, hereinafter referred to as the Interparliamentary Conference on SECG.

These Rules of Procedure are designed to facilitate and improve the work of the Interparliamentary Conference on Economic and Financial Governance of the European Union, hereinafter referred to as the Interparliamentary Conference on EFG.

# PREAMBLE Second Paragraph

# Seimas of the Republic of Lithuania

#### Amendment:

The Interparliamentary Conference on **EFG** SECG shall be organised in accordance with the decisions of the Conference of Speakers of the European Union Parliaments taken on 23 April 2013 in Nicosia and on 8 April 2014 in Vilnius to establish a conference foreseen in Article 13 of the Treaty on Stability, Coordination and Governance in the Economic and Monetary Union (hereinafter referred to as the TSCG), Protocol 1 of the Treaty of Lisbon on the role of national Parliaments in the European Union and the Guidelines for Interparliamentary Cooperation in the European Union as adopted at the Conference of Speakers on 21 June 2008 in Lisbon.

The Interparliamentary Conference on EFG shall provide a framework for debate and exchange of information and best practices in order to strengthen cooperation between national Parliaments and the European Parliament on matters of economic and financial governance of the EU and shall maintain a special focus on the budgetary issues and procedures covered by the TSCG and contribute to ensuring democratic accountability and legitimacy of decision making in the area of [OPTION 1] economic and financial governance [OPTION 2] economic governance and budgetary policy in the EU, particularly in the EMU, taking into account the social dimension, without prejudice to the competences of EU Parliaments.

The Interparliamentary Conference on SECG shall provide a framework for debate and exchange of information and best practices in order to strengthen cooperation between national Parliaments and the European Parliament and contribute to ensuring enhancing democratic accountability and legitimacy in the area of economic governance and budgetary policy in the EU, particularly in the EMU, taking into account the social dimension, without prejudice to the competences of existing competences and procedures EU Parliaments.

# Polish Sejm

#### Amendment:

The Interparliamentary Conference on **EFG** replaces the meetings of the chairpersons of relevant committees organised in the framework of the parliamentary dimension of the Presidency of the Council by **each** national Parliament of the Member State holding the Presidency, hereinafter referred to as the Presidency Parliament, and the European Parliamentary Week of the European Semester organised by the European Parliament in the first semester of each year.

1.2 The Interparliamentary Conference on **EFG** SECG replaces the meetings of the chairpersons of relevant committees organised in the framework of the parliamentary dimension of the Presidency of the Council by each the national Parliament of the Member State holding the Presidency, hereinafter referred to as the Presidency Parliament.

1.3 The Interparliamentary Conference on SECG may, in accordance with the procedures laid down in Article 7 of these Rules of Procedure, adopt conclusions on matters related to the conference's scope.

The Conclusions shall not bind national Parliaments or the European Parliament or and shall not prejudge their positions.

The Interparliamentary Conference on SECG may, in accordance with the procedures laid down in Article 7 of these Rules of Procedure, adopt conclusions on matters related to the conference's scope. The Conclusions shall not bind national Parliaments or the European Parliament and shall not prejudge their positions.

## **ARTICLE 2.1**

## German Bundestag

#### Amendment:

The Interparliamentary Conference on EFG SECG shall convene at least twice a year. It shall be coordinated with the cycle of the European Semester. In the first semester of each year, it shall be held in Brussels in **April** and will be co-hosted and co-presided over by the Presidency Parliament and the European Parliament. In the second semester of each year, it shall be held in the Member State holding the Presidency and presided over by the Presidency Parliament. **The conferences shall be clearly distinguishable from other parallel events.**

The Interparliamentary Conference on SECG shall convene twice a year. It shall be coordinated with the cycle of the European Semester. In the first semester of each year, it shall be held in Brussels and will be co-hosted and co-presided over by the Presidency Parliament and the European Parliament. In the second semester of each year, it shall be held in the Member State holding the Presidency and presided over by the Presidency Parliament, in close cooperation with the European Parliament.

## **ARTICLE 2.3**

# Seimas of the Republic of Lithuania

The hosting Parliament(s) shall be responsible for providing the secretariat. The secretariat of the European Parliament and the co-hosting Presidency Parliament, as well as the hosting Presidency Parliament of the second semester should stay in contact to ensure the continuity of the work of the Interparliamentary Conference on **EFG** SECG.

#### **ARTICLE 2.4**

## European Parliament

## Amendment:

At the beginning of each meeting, the presiding Parliament(s) shall set the timetable of the meeting and shall determine the order and the length of interventions. Meetings shall be chaired by the chairperson(s) of the relevant committees of the presiding Parliament(s) or their representatives.

# **ARTICLE 2.5**

# European Parliament

#### Amendment:

The secretariat(s) of the presiding Parliament(s) shall prepare the necessary documents and shall draw up a brief minutes summary of the meeting.

## 2.5-bis Side events

Apart from the plenary meeting, side events, such as topical debates in political groups, working groups or break-out sessions, can be organised in the framework of the





Interparliamentary Conference on EFG, including by Parliaments other than the presiding Parliament(s). Any delegate to the conference may attend and participate in such side events.

## **ARTICLE 2.6**

# Hungarian National Assembly

# Amendments:

In general the Interparliamentary Conference on SECG shall seek to take decisions, including on the adoption of the Conclusions, by consensus. If this is not possible, decisions shall be taken with a qualified majority of at least 3/4 of the votes cast. The majority of 3/4 of the votes cast must at the same time constitute at least 2/3 of all votes. The delegations opposing certain parts or points of the text may submit their separate opinion to the Conclusions.

Each Parliament has two votes. In the case of bicameral Parliaments, each Chamber is given one vote.

## Seimas of the Republic of Lithuania

#### Amendment:

In general the Interparliamentary Conference on EFG [SECG] shall seek to take decisions, including on the adoption of the Conclusions, by consensus. If this is not possible, decisions shall be taken with a qualified majority of at least 3/4 of the votes cast. The majority of 3/4 of the votes cast must at the same time constitute at least 2/3 of all votes. Each Parliament has two votes. In the case of bicameral Parliaments, each Chamber is given one vote.

## Amendment:

## 2.6 Voting Modus operandi

The Interparliamentary Conference on SECG shall adopt its decisions, including on the adoption of the Conclusions, by consensus.

Throughout its workings the Conference shall operate on the basis of the principle of consensus.

The Interparliamentary on **EFG** shall adopt its decisions, including on the adoption of the Conclusions by consensus.

# **ARTICLE 2.7**

## Seimas of the Republic of Lithuania

#### Amendment:

Meetings of the Interparliamentary Conference on **EFG** SECG shall be public, unless otherwise determined.





## **ARTICLE 3.1**

# Cyprus House of Representatives

## Amendment:

National Parliaments should be represented by a maximum number of six Members of Parliament each. In case of a National Parliament consisting of two Chambers, the number of Members of its delegations shall be allocated according to their internal agreement. The European Parliament shall be represented by a maximum number of sixteen Members. The decision on the composition of delegations should rest upon each Parliament.

# Seimas of the Republic of Lithuania

## Amendment:

The Interparliamentary Conference on **EFG** SECG is composed of delegations from the relevant committees of the national Parliaments of the EU Members States and the European Parliament. The composition and size of delegations shall be determined by each Parliament.

#### **ARTICLE 3.2**

## European Parliament

#### Amendment:

National Parliaments of EU candidate countries can be represented by a delegation of a maximum of two observers each. The presiding Parliament(s) may also invite, after consulting the Presidential Troika, observers from other EU institutions or bodies as well as from EEA-EFTA countries.

# **ARTICLE 3.3**

# European Parliament

# Amendment:

The President of the European Council, the President of the Eurogroup and the competent members of the European Commission and other EU Institutions shall be invited to the Interparliamentary Conference on SECG to set out take part in the discussion of the priorities and strategies of the EU in the areas being discussed covered by the Conference.

## Amendment:

The President of the European Council, the President of the Eurogroup and the competent members of the European Commission and other EU Institutions shall be invited to the Interparliamentary Conference on **EFG** SECC to set out the priorities and strategies of the EU in the areas being discussed by the Conference.

#### **ARTICLE 3.4**

## European Parliament





The presiding Parliament(s), after consulting the Presidential Troika, may also invite special guests and experts as observers.

#### **ARTICLE 4.1**

## European Parliament

## Amendment:

A draft agenda shall be drawn up by the presiding Parliament(s) in close cooperation with the Presidential Troika.

With regard to the Conference of the first semester, the agenda shall be drawn up by the Presiding Parliaments. The agenda of the Conference of the second semester shall be drawn up by the presiding Parliament in close cooperation with the European Parliament.

The Delegations may propose specific items to be put on or deleted from the agenda. to the presiding Parliament(s) that a specific item be put on or removed from the draft agenda.

# German Bundestag

#### Amendment:

A draft agenda shall be drawn up by the presiding Parliament(s) in close cooperation with the Presidential Troika. The delegations may propose to the presiding Parliament(s) that a specific item be put on or removed from the draft agenda. The decision on the final agenda shall be made by the Interparliamentary Conference on EFG at the beginning of every meeting.

## **ARTICLE 5.1**

## Amendment:

The working languages of the Interparliamentary Conference on **EFG** SECG shall be English and French and German.

## **ARTICLE 5.2**

# German Bundestag

## Amendment:

Simultaneous interpretation from and into English, and French and German as well as from and into the language of the Presidency Member State shall be provided by the host Parliament(s). Simultaneous interpretation into additional languages may be provided if requested and its costs would be borne by





the relevant national delegation or the European Parliament. The host Parliament will make available the appropriate technical facilities.

Documents of the Interparliamentary Conference on **EFG** SECG shall be communicated to national Parliaments and the European Parliament in English, and French and German.

#### **ARTICLE 6.1**

# European Parliament

## Amendment:

6. CONCLUSIONS

6.1. The Interparliamentary Conference on SECG may adopt non-binding conclusions on matters within the scope of the Conference.

The **presiding Parliament(s)** of the Interparliamentary Conference on EFG may adopt publish non-binding Conclusions on the outcome of the meeting on matters within the scope of the Conference.

# **ARTICLE 6.2**

## European Parliament

Draft conclusions of the Interparliamentary Conference on SECG shall be drawn up by the presiding Parliament(s) in English and French, in close cooperation with the Presidential Troika, and communicated to all delegations before the relevant meeting in a reasonable time for any amendments to be considered and submitted.

## German Bundestag

#### Amendment:

Draft conclusions of the Interparliamentary Conference on **EFG** SECG shall be drawn up by the presiding Parliament(s) in English, and French and German, in close cooperation with the Presidential Troika, and communicated to all delegations at least one week before the relevant meeting in a reasonable time for, so any proposed amendments could be considered and submitted.

Draft conclusions of the Interparliamentary Conference on **EFG** SECG shall be drawn up by the presiding Parliament(s) in English and French, in close cooperation with the Presidential Troika, and communicated to all delegations before the relevant meeting in a reasonable time for any amendments to be considered and submitted.

## **ARTICLE 6.3**

# European Parliament

## Amendment:

6.3. Once the conclusions have been adopted, the presiding Parliament(s) shall communicate the final texts in English and French, each of these texts being equally authentic, to all delegations, to the Presidents of national Parliaments and of the European Parliament, to the Presidents of the European Council and the European Commission, and the competent Commissioners and members of European Institutions, for their information.

Once the **Presidency** conclusions have been adopted **published**, the presiding Parliament(s) shall communicate the final texts in English and French and German, each of these texts being equally authentic, to all delegations, to the Presidents of national Parliaments and of the European Parliament, to the Presidents of the European Council and the European Commission, and the competent Commissioners and members of European Institutions, for their information.

#### Amendment:

# **ARTICLE 7.1**

## Amendment:

Any national Parliament and the European Parliament may submit proposals to amend these **practical** arrangements Rules of Procedure. Amendments shall be submitted in writing to all national Parliaments and the European Parliament at least four weeks before meetings of the Interparliamentary Conference on SECG.

## Amendment:

Any amendments, which the delegations of national Parliaments or the European Parliament may propose to the Rules of Procedure practical arrangements, shall be subject to a decision by consensus by the Interparliamentary Conference on SECG and must be in accordance with the framework set by the Conference of Speakers of the EU Parliaments.

Any decisions on the Rules of Procedure which the delegations of national Parliaments or the European Parliament may propose shall be subject to a decision by consensus by the





Interparliamentary Conference on **EFG** and must be in accordance with the framework set by the Conference of Speakers of EU Parliaments.

To this end the Interparliamentary Conference on EFG SECG may appoint an *ad hoc* review committee. The relevant Presidency Parliament shall submit the conclusions of the review together with specific recommendations to be deliberated upon by the Conference of Speakers of European Union Parliaments in 2018 2016. The workings shall be evaluated at the latest every five years thereafter.
